### Presentation

#### **Red Deer Catering Proposal**

Red Deer Catering representatives Andrew Stone and Colin Stone presented Council with a proposal for onsite catering at the Lacombe Memorial Centre (LMC). The caterers proposed a partnership with the LMC to drive new revenue streams for the City and grow the number of catered events in Lacombe.

### Council & Legislative

#### **Endorsement of Support**

Council passed a resolution to support equitable treatment for all communities in accessing federal and provincial funding programs.

### Recreation Services

#### **Ice Resurfacer RFP**

Council approved the purchase of the Olympia Millennium H Ice Resurfacer from Big Hill Services, with trade-in of the City's existing 2009 Zamboni 525 ice resurfacer, for a net cost of \$87,496.00 + GST.

### Corporate Services

#### **2019 Census**

Council directed Administration to conduct a municipal census in 2019, to be funded by an adjustment to the capital reserve contributions. Council also designated April 2, 2019, as Census Day in Lacombe.

#### **Local Emergency Management Regulations**

Council accepted the report on the new Local Authority Emergency Management Regulations as information.

### Motions Out of Camera

#### **Alberta Order of Excellence Nominations**

Council directed Administration to submit an award nomination for the Alberta Order of Excellence for any individual identified by a member of Council.

#### **Catering Proposal**

Council directed Administration to decline the proposal from Red Deer Catering to provide semi-exclusive catering at the Lacombe Memorial Centre.
