Dear Residents of Lacombe,

As part of the City of Lacombe's West Area Servicing Project, a new water main is to be installed connecting to the proposed Midway Lift Station along 76 St. The tentative schedule for construction start is on or about March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019, and work in this area is anticipated to last 1 week (weather pending). No road closures or detours are planned as part of this phase of construction, however lane reductions will be required.



The City of Lacombe will be providing a more comprehensive notice to residents in the coming weeks to advise them of other phases of work that will require parking restrictions and road or lane closures later this year.

During construction please keep a safe distance from the construction site and the equipment. The contractor will take every precaution to protect the public, but the contractor will need your assistance.

Hours of Construction will be from 7 am to 7 pm Monday to Saturday. Sunday work and evening work may also be required as weather and schedule requirements dictate. In these circumstances the noise bylaw will be adhered to.
