## RE: Early Trash to Treasure

Thank you for your written concern regarding premature Trash to Treasure or Spring Clean Up Concern.

An incident of this same nature was reported to Director Piché by a concerned citizen. She instructed Bylaw Enforcement to address the occupants of the violating properties. All of the residents were compliant and moved the items off of their yard for now. Bylaw Enforcement informed each of the residents of the actual times of the Trash to Treasure and Spring Clean Up.

Following the incident, Bylaw Enforcement said that it was an honest error - the resident related the community events to a holiday. Because Easter was late this year, the resident assumed that the clean up events were going to happening shortly thereafter.

There will be announcements and notifications of the Trash to Treasure and Spring Clean Up events on the various media channels such as the City's website, social media, Community Pages in the newspapers, and Community Moments on the radio.
