Thank you for your written concern regarding the walking path behind the Lacombe Composite High School. The City shares your concerns regarding the littering and gathering in this area.


The City has had discussions with the high school administration and we will continue to work together to educate students and citizens on any community standards infractions.

The Wolf Creek School Division has a policy for zero tolerance of smoking on school property. In September of 2018, the City has passed a Smoking Bylaw that prohibits smoking in parks and on trails. Due to the new Smoking Bylaw, signage will be installed and increased patrols will occur by the Bylaw Enforcement Officers. The City will also place more garbage receptacles in the area to alleviate littering.

The City's Bylaw Enforcement Officers will work together with Lacombe Police Service, the School Resource Officer, Wolf Creek School Division, and other community partners to combat this issue and hope that it will result in a positive outcome to restore the area for its intended purpose and use for all citizens.
