RE: Highway 12 Paving Update

Thank you for your written concern regarding the pavement restoration along Highway 12 between 58th Street and 76th Street. The patches that are currently in place are temporary and the majority of them will be replaced with permanent patches by the end of June.

The reason permanent patches were not completed immediately is due to the depth of the waterline which was installed approximately 3m deep. It is important to allow the backfill in the excavations additional time to settle before completing the permanent patch to prevent future issues with settlement in the final patch. The contractor elected to install temporary patches and re-open the road in order to minimize impact to the public, rather than closing half the highway for several months.

A portion of Highway 12 will also be milled and paved as part of the 58th Street and 76th Street intersection projects later this summer.
