

Community Clean Up Campaign



Purpose

Provides residents with an opportunity to dispose of household and yard refuse that can not be placed in regular garbage bins.

Dates

- **Spring Clean Up:** Tuesday after the May long weekend.
- **Fall Clean Up:** Tuesday after the Thanksgiving weekend.

How do I prepare for pick-up?

Place all items for disposal **at the front your property.**

- Do not place items on the sidewalk, alley or street.
- Debris left in the alleys will not be picked up.
- Ensure that pedestrian and vehicle traffic are not blocked.
- Do not place refuse next to or touching the bin used for normal household garbage pick-up.

Items must be placed outside by 7 a.m. on the day your area is scheduled for pick-up.

Refuse must be organized and separated into piles for pick-up.

- Different trucks and equipment are designated to pick up certain items; therefore having separated piles will ease operations.
- It is the responsibility of the homeowner to separate these piles.
- All items must be sorted and neatly tied, bundled or bagged.
- Trees, brush or limbs cannot be more than 10 feet long or they will not be picked up.

How do I sort refuse?

- **Brush & wood:** Treated, painted & stained wood needs to be separated into a general rubble pile
- **Leaves, sod & garden waste:** These items can also be taken to either the Wolf Creek recycle site. In addition, leaves and garden waste can be disposed of in the green colored yard waste bins spread throughout the city.
- **Metals**
- **Appliances including fridge, freezers and air conditioning units:** All food must be removed
- **Furniture**
- **Swing sets & trampolines:** Dismantle and separate according to metal/plastic components
- **E-waste:** T.V.'s, computers, printers, etc.

Are there any items that the City will not pick up?

- **Unmanageable piles & piles not sorted or separated**
- **Hazardous waste:** Oil, cleaning solutions, paint, antifreeze, aerosols, railway ties, and tires etc. Residents can dispose of these items in September.
- **Construction waste:** Drywall, concrete, deck and fence boards, roofing materials, porcelain toilets or sinks, and renovation materials.
- **Cardboard:** Recycle material placed in your Blue Bin or taken to the Wolf Creek Recycle Site for disposal

Items not picked up

Any items left on your property or placed out after your scheduled pick up date will remain the responsibility of the property owner. City crews will not return after they have completed pick up in your area. Items not picked up can then be taken to the Prentiss Transfer Station.
