

LACOMBE ARTS ENDOWMENT GRANTS

The Lacombe Arts Endowment Fund provides two streams of funding:

1. Major arts grants for emerging and established music, vocal, literary and visual artists of all ages within the City and County of Lacombe. Up to \$2,500 per grant is available for continuing education in the arts. (Emerging artists are those who have been taking lessons for several years, and wish to continue in their chosen field of study to expand their skill level.)
2. Three \$250 student art awards: The Jan Holoboff Jr. High School Art Award, the Charlie Donald Memorial High School Art Award, and the Dustin Peers Memorial Drawing Award, are given each year during the Encore Art Show & Sale in April.

Major Grants:

The application process for the major arts grants opens January 1 of each year, and closes the last business day of March. We highly recommend that you do not wait until the last week to apply. It is not uncommon for there to be issues with thumb drives, or dvd's and you may need to bring in a replacement. If the replacement is not received by the deadline, your application cannot be considered.

Due to the generous donors in our community, there are three \$250 student art awards available: The Jan Holoboff Jr. High School Art Award, The Charlie Donald Memorial High School Award, and the Dustin Peers Memorial Drawing Award.
