

Crop Damage

Policy Number: 12/230.01 (02)
Adopted: Jan. 14/02

This policy replaces 12/230.01 86 and amended in 1988. It is recognized that from time to time the Town of Lacombe may have to enter upon private farm land to do maintenance work on Wolf Creek and other utility and road rights of way. In order to do maintenance work as described above, it is agreed that the Town of Lacombe will pay the following rates in 2002, the said rates will be reviewed by Council in April of each year starting in 2003.

2002 CROP DAMAGE PAYMENT

1. Acquisition of Right-of-Way
 - a) For right-of-way with purchase finalized prior to this crop year as expenses for weed control \$50.00/acre
 - b) For right-of-way with purchase not finalized prior to this crop year:

Oil Seed	\$250/acre
Grain	\$225/acre
Tame Hay or Pasture	\$240/acre
2. Backsloping

Oil Seed	\$250/acre
Grain	\$225/acre
Tame Hay or Pasture	\$240/acre
Native Hay or Pasture	\$120/acre
Summerfallow	\$50/acre
Brush	\$25/acre

- a) Where crop received hail prior to the damage by the Town, the preceding rates are to be pro-rated between the summerfallow rates and the respective crop rate based on the percentage of hail loss.
3. Where crops are damaged as a result of the Town entering upon land to do maintenance work to the right-of-way on Wolfe Creek, the rates will be the same as Section (2) - Backsloping.
