OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION

The Pidherneys underground crew are advancing into Stage 2 of the Main Street construction this week, likely Wednesday or Thursday. The construction zone will be expanded to the east of 51 Street and south on 49C Avenue to the northside of the parking lots entrances adjacent to Highway 2A. The concrete crew will be in the Stage 1 area replacing the sidewalks. Pedestrian accessibility will be maintained in both areas.

Construction work is proceeding as scheduled. The Stage 1 area expected to be open to traffic in the first half of July on a temporary surface, and the Stage 2 area is expected to be open to traffic in the latter half of July on a temporary surface. Work on the Flatiron Building parking lot is not scheduled until later in the summer, so there are still nearby parking options.
