

**TOWN OF LACOMBE  
BYLAW 29**

**Consolidation to January 9<sup>th</sup>, 1984**

A By-law of the Town of Lacombe for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway in accordance with Sections 108, 182 and 183 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26. Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980:

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a Bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting that portion of the highway so proposed to be closed, at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the Bylaw, and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a Bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Globe on April 13 and April 20, 1983, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council, of the Town of Lacombe, does hereby close the following described highway:

Firstly – all that portion of lane lying south of the Production easterly of the north boundary of Block Y, Plan 3540U across said lane and north of the north limit of University Avenue. (01/09/84)

Secondly – all that portion of University Avenue lying east of the east boundary of Block Y said Plan (NW 19-40-26-4) excepting thereout all mines and minerals. (01/09/84)

Subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.

READ a first time this 9<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D., 1983

READ a second time this 9<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D., 1983

APPROVED this 5<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D., 1983

READ a third time and passed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D., 1983
