

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 61**

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing and selling a portion of a public highway.

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe for the purpose of closing and selling a portion of a public highway in accordance with Section 180 and 183 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980;

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application had been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a Bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting that portion of the highway so proposed to be closed, at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the bylaw, and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a Bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Globe on October 30 and November, 1985, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council, of the Town of Lacombe, does hereby close the following described highway;

All that portion of Original Road Allowance adjoining the East boundary of the SE $\frac{3}{4}$ 30-40-26-4 which lies North of the production easterly of the South boundary of Lot 15, Block 33, Plan 1302 HW and which lies South of the Easterly production of the northerly curvilinear boundary of said Lot 15, Block 33, Plan 1302 HW subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.

READ a first time this 28th day of October, AD 1985.

READ a second time this 25th day of November, AD 1985.

READ a third time and passed this 10th day of February, AD 1986.
