

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 45**

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway.

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway in accordance with Section 180 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980;

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a Bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting that portion of the highway so proposed to be closed, at least two weeks before the days fixed for the passing of the Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a Bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Globe on May 2 and May 9, 1984, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council, of the Town of Lacombe, does hereby close the following described highway:

All that portion of original road allowance lying south of a line extended along the curve of the north boundary of Lot 15, Block 33, Plan 1302 HW easterly across said ORA and lying north of a line extended along the south boundary of Lot 15, Block 33, Plan 1302 HW easterly across said ORA.

Subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.
