

**TOWN OF LACOMBE  
BYLAW 134**

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta for the purposes of closing and selling of that portion of Road Plan 3672 J located in the South East Quarter of Section 19-40-26-W4th.

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF Lacombe for the purpose of closing and selling a portion of public highway in accordance with section 180 and 183 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980;

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS application to pass a bylaw has been made to Council to have the highway closed; and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting that portion of the highway so proposed to be closed, at least two (2) weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the bylaw; and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Globe on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 1990 and June 6<sup>th</sup>, 1990, the least of such publication being at least two (2) weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Lacombe duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. The public road surveyed within the south east quarter of section 19-40-26-W4th under Road Plan 3672 J be closed and sold.

Subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.

READ A SECOND TIME this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1990

GIVEN THIRD READING and passed this 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1990.
