

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 164**

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing certain roads or portions thereof.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 180 and 183 in the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, deems it expedient to provide a bylaw for the purpose of closing certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality; and

WHEREAS the roads hereinafter described are no longer required for public travel and will be sold for incorporation into the adjacent lots for the purpose of facilitating a proposed subdivision development; and

WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this bylaw has been given in accordance with the provisions of the said Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS no person has claimed to be affected prejudicially by this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Lacombe, in the Provinces of Alberta, in open council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, "road" shall mean street, road, lane or public highway.
2. The following roads, or portions thereof, are hereby closed:

"All that portion of the statutory road allowance adjoining the east boundary of the North East quarter of Section 30-40-26-W4th lying north of the production easterly across the said road allowance of the north boundary of U. R/W Plan 792-1515."

3. The land referred to in Section 2 above shall be sold for incorporation into the adjacent lots for the purpose of facilitating a proposed subdivision development.
