

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 124**

A Bylaw of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing and selling a portion of a public walkway.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, revised statutes of Alberta 1980, Chapter M-26, Sections 180 and 183, and amendments thereto, deems it expedient to provide a bylaw for the purpose of closing certain public walkways, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality; and

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting that portion of the walkway so proposed to be closed, at least two (2) weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the bylaw; and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Globe on June 21st, and June 28th, 1989, the last of such publication being at least two (2) weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the bylaw; and

WHEREAS all persons who claimed to be affected prejudicially by this bylaw, or their agents, have been heard by the Council,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

1. The following public walkway, or portion thereof, is hereby closed:

"All that portion of the public walkway lying between Lots 5 and 6, Block 3, Plan 802-0876".

2. Equal portions of the land referred to in Section 2 above shall be sold to the adjacent land owners.
