

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 259**

A by-law of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, to provide for the closure to public travel, and the sale of a lane within the Town of Lacombe in accordance with s 22 of *the Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M26.1, revised statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lacombe deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel a certain road, situated within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Lacombe, and thereafter selling the same; and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with S606 of *The Municipal Government Act*, supra, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and sell the following described highway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

Plan 4331 HW
Block 38
All that portion of the lane
Lying west of the production northerly of the east
boundary of Lot 2 said block and plan.
(S.E. 30-40-26-4)
Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

1. This By-law shall take effect upon final passing thereof
