

**TOWN OF LACOMBE  
BYLAW 271**

A Bylaw of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta to allow the use of a portion of the Environmental Reserve adjacent to Cranna Lake for the construction of an extension to Woodland Drive

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lacombe has deemed it expedient and proper pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, S.A. 1994 c. M-26.1, s. 676 to pass a bylaw to use a portion of environmental reserve for the purpose of constructing and extension of Woodland Drive to 58th Street; and

WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this by-law has been given in accordance with the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LACOMBE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA IN OPEN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That portion of Environmental Reserve Lot 2 ER, Block 4 Plan 942-3430 adjacent to Cranna Lake as shown in Schedule A be used for the construction of an extension to Woodland Drive.
2. Schedule A shall form part of this Bylaw
3. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon passage of final reading.
