

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 292**

Consolidated to April 22, 2002

A Bylaw of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing to public travel and create title to portions of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the roads closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Lacombe deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to, and

WHEREAS, Attachment 'A' which shows the location of the lands described hereafter, is attached and forms part of this Bylaw, and

WHEREAS, Notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, does hereby close to public travel and create title to the following described highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:

1. All that portion of original Road Allowance adjoining the west boundary of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-One (32), Township Forty (40), Range Twenty-Six (26), West of the Fourth Meridian.
 - a. All that portion which lies between the Easterly production of the North and South limits of the Avenue (College Avenue) as shown on Plan 4046 B.N. (April 25, 2002)
 - b. All that portion which lies South of the course Pl. I R4 to Pl. I R5 to Pl. I. R6 as shown on Plan 942 1359. (April 25, 2002)
2. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals. (April 25, 2002)
