

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 172**

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the Municipal Council to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Alberta as represented by the Minister of the Environment.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta a council may pass a bylaw authorizing the making of an agreement with the Government of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the council and the Government of Alberta, or its agents, to be a benefit to both parties;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Lacombe is the registered owner of the SW 29-40-26-W4M;

AND WHEREAS the Lands were once used as a sewage lagoon and have been reclaimed by the Minister at the request of the Owner;

AND WHEREAS the Owner and the Minister agree that as a result of the Lands' proper usage, the Lands may now be unstable for certain purposes and therefore the Owner and the Minister agree that certain investigations should be conducted on the Lands by the Owner and his successors in title should change in use of the Lands be proposed;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Lacombe in Council assembled enacts as follows:

THAT the Mayor and the municipal Secretary of the Town of Lacombe be and are hereby empowered to execute an agreement similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A" between the said Town and Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Alberta as represented by the Minister of the Environment.
