

**TOWN OF LACOMBE  
BYLAW 211**

A Bylaw of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing certain roads or portions thereof.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of Municipal Government Act, S.A. 1994, c. M-26.1 ss. 22 and 606, deems it expedient to provide a by-law for the purpose of closing certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality; and

WHEREAS the roads hereinafter described are no longer required for public travel and will be sold for incorporation into the adjacent lots for the purpose of facilitating a proposed subdivision development; and

WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this by-law has been advertised in accordance with the provisions of the said Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS no person has claimed to be affected prejudicially by this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, in open council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this by-law, "road" shall mean street, road, lane or public highway.
2. All that portion of the remaining statutory road allowance adjoining the east boundary of the SE 31-40-26-W4th lying south of the production easterly of the south boundary of road plan 4906 TR is hereby closed.
3. The land referred to in Section 2 of this by-law shall be sold for incorporation into the adjacent property for the purpose of facilitating a proposed subdivision development.
4. This bylaw shall come into effect upon final passage.
